



- I An <u>elephant</u> is a very big animal and you can see it in the zoo. It is bigger than a hippo and has a long nose.
- 2 The <u>giraffe</u> is taller than other animals. They have long necks so they can eat the leaves at the top of trees.
- 3 The <u>cheetah</u> is a big cat. It is smaller than a lion, but can run faster. It usually eats small deer.
